



## **2022 PRIDE PARADE RULES AND REGULATIONS**

### **PARADE RULES AND CONDUCT:**

1. There will be no carnival-type costumes (i.e. no exposed midriffs, no exposed chest areas, no exposed private parts, no short-shorts, no bikinis or swimwear, no indecent/obscene graphics or writing on clothing...) individuals can wear pride related clothing but it has to be deemed appropriate for the parade. Any clothing/accessories which are deemed inappropriate must be removed or the individual will not be permitted to participate in the parade. We will offer a t-shirt in order to allow participation in the Parade.
2. There will be no alcohol prior to or during the parade. Any inebriated persons will be asked to leave the parade.
3. Parade participants are required to refrain from improper conduct and public indecency including over display of affection (kissing is allowed but no tongue), whining or gyrating, exposing of private parts.

The rules are subject to change in the event the Cayman Islands Government has made any changes as per the law due to COVID.
